Visas

- Participants from a Visa Exemption Arrangement designated country are allowed to enter Indonesia without a diplomatic or service visa (*Philippines, Cambodia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam*)
- Diplomatic/service passports or UNLPs – apply for Visa on Arrival through the Secretariat
- National passports:
 - Visa on Arrival for Nationals of 43 countries listed in Annex A of Logistics Note or
 - e-visa to be applied for through the Secretariat with the support of colleagues in Indonesia (more information in the logistics note)

Visas – Visa on Arrival

Who needs to apply

- Holders of Diplomatic or Service passports or UNLP from any of the countries being invited to the SMM
- Nationals of 43 countries listed in Annex A regardless of type of passport

Documents to be submitted by 28 April to the SWA Secretariat

- Copy of passport bio page showing full name
- Nationality
- Passport number
- Type of passport (diplomatic, service, or regular)
- Name of Institution
- Position

Visas – E-Visa

Who needs to apply

E-visa is available for participants traveling on their national passports and whose country is NOT on the list of 43 countries in Annex A.

Documents to be submitted by 28 April to the SWA Secretariat

- Passport bio page (**Note- the passport must have a minimum validity period of 6 months prior to e-visa submission*)
- Itinerary or air ticket (**Note- this will be generated by SWA if the traveler is sponsored by SWA*)
- Signed statement letter stating the person's willingness to comply with health protocols in Indonesia and willingness to cover any health costs which arise independently. Each traveler is requested to use the statement to fill in their details, sign the statement letter in and return a copy to the SWA Secretariat.
- Passport photo in color with white background
- Vaccination certificate and make a verification through this link:
<https://vaksinln.dto.kemkes.go.id/user>. (**Note- people who are not fully vaccinated need to bring a doctor certified statement exempting them from vaccination.*)

Visas – E-Visa (cont.)

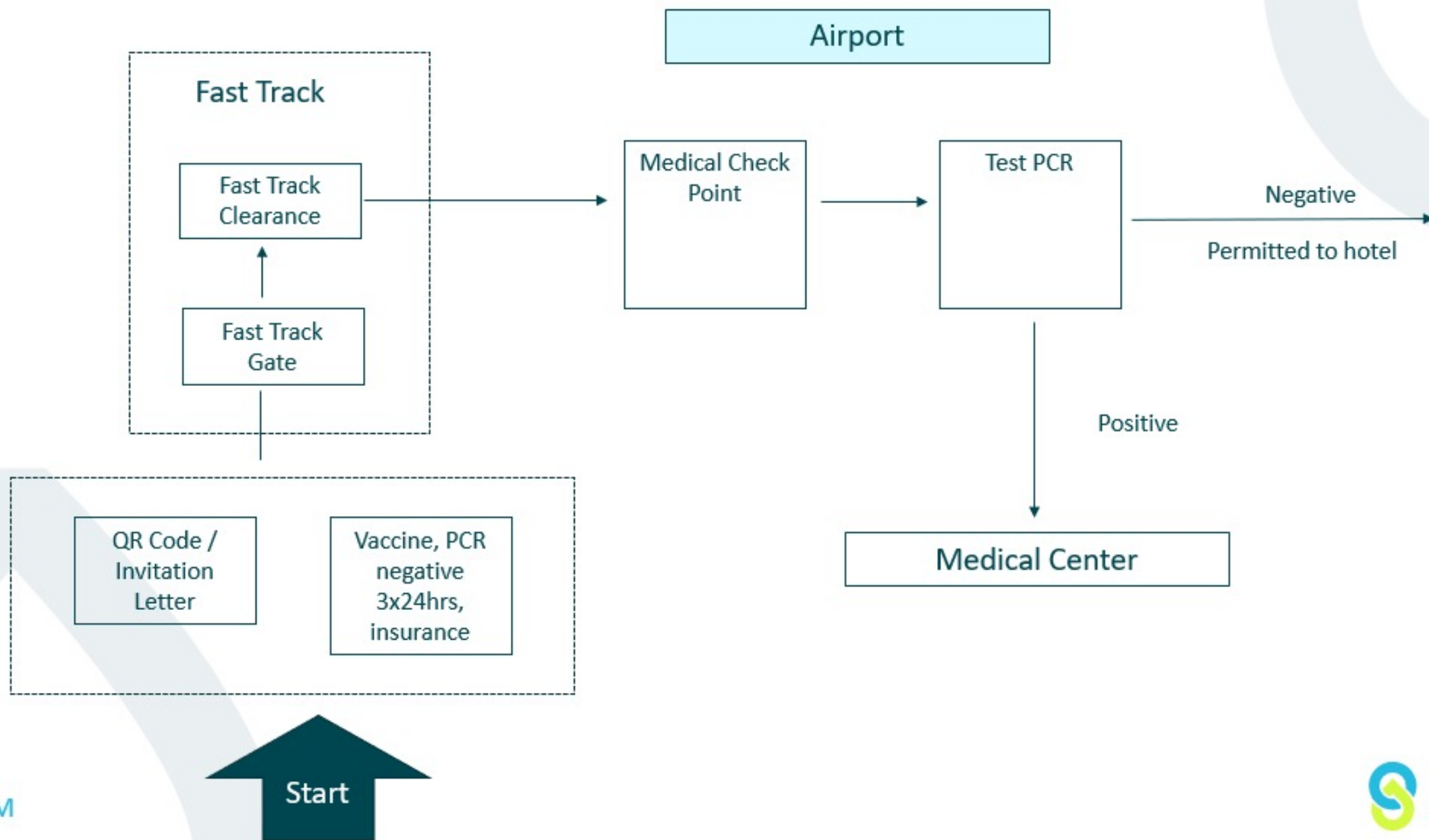
Documents you must bring with you to Indonesia

- Passport
- Return ticket
- Proof of insurance of minimum value of 25,000 USD
- Copy of the approved E-Visa
- Negative PCR test result within 48 hours of departure
- Vaccination certificate and make a verification through this link: <https://vaksinln.dto.kemkes.go.id/user>. (**Note- people who are not fully vaccinated need to bring a doctor certified statement exempting them from vaccination.*)

Minimum health requirements

- Be fully vaccinated
- Have appropriate health insurance
- Negative PCR test 48hrs prior to departure as well as periodic antigen tests at the meeting
