Key principles for the UN 2023 Water Conference

VISION STATEMENT UN 2023 WATER CONFERENCE



- Inclusive: both in terms of (a) the Conference process (ensure vertical and horizontal inclusiveness) and in terms of (b) the results (leaving no-one behind)
- Action-oriented: lead to concrete results through concrete actions and plans on the ground
- Cross-sectoral: mobilize all other sectors to improve the way they manage and utilize water resources. These sectors need to bring their plans and actions to the Conference

- Plenaries
 - 6 Plenaries
 - Member States have a space to make their statements in the General Assembly
 - Accredited stakeholders can be observers
- Interactive dialogues
 - 5 Dialogues
- Side Events
 - Member States and other stakeholders will organize many side events that are cross-cutting and aim for action
- Special Events
 - Co-hosts decided to strive to have 4 Special Events organized by major groups, scope: 50-200 people
- Cultural elements and more
 - Marathons, exhibitions, action zones, New York Water Week (18-24 March) and many more
- Closing of the Conference (Friday 24 March 15:00 hrs)
